Practical tips for shampooing your pet

Thoroughly wet your dog all over using luke warm water

The more water you get into the coat the easier it is to shampoo.

Apply shampoo to several points

Pouring shampoo down the back of your pet will use more than required. Dermcare-Vet products are concentrated so you only need to use a small amount of shampoo. Depending on coat length, use 1-2 teaspoons of shampoo per 5 kg dog.

Use a sponge

Particularly around the face to gently massage the shampoo into the coat and skin. Don't forget the muzzle, lips and under the tail.

When lathering up, add more water before you add more shampoo

Dermcare-Vet products have minimal water added to them. You can always add more water, so why pay extra for it?

Rinse thoroughly with lukewarm water

Repeat procedure for added lustre. Your pet should be "squeaky" clean. If the hair doesn't squeak, there is still shampoo residue which needs to be removed.

Dry gently with a towel or chamois

Using excessive heat or vigorous towel drying can irritate the skin, making it itchy.
